# What is Salvation?

# Holy Communion

Matthew 7: 21-23

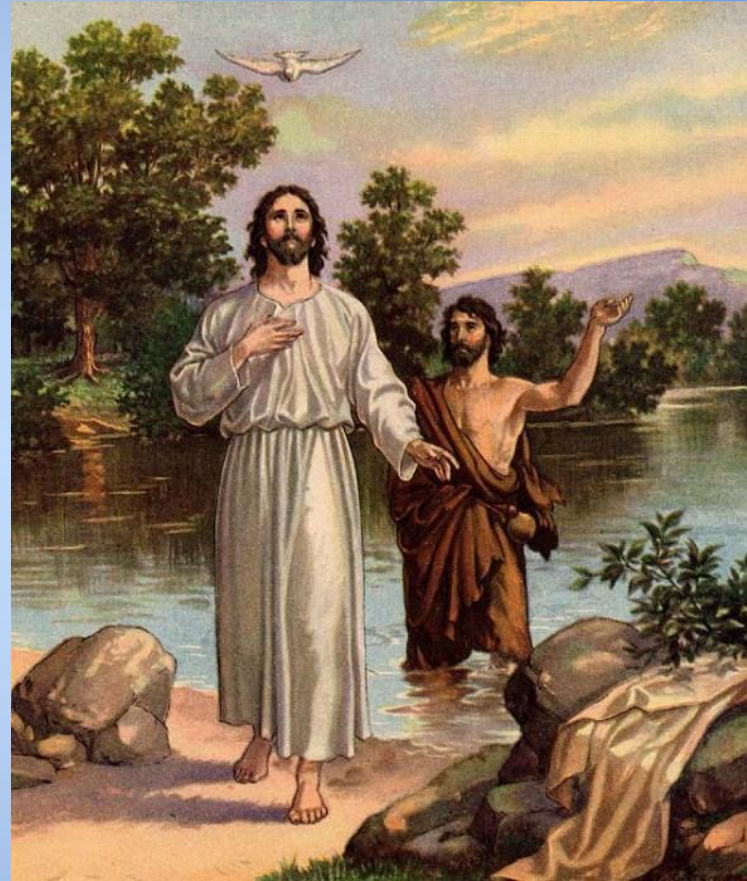


# Baptism

# Crucifixion of Jesus Christ

All the sins of the old testament were merely “put away”

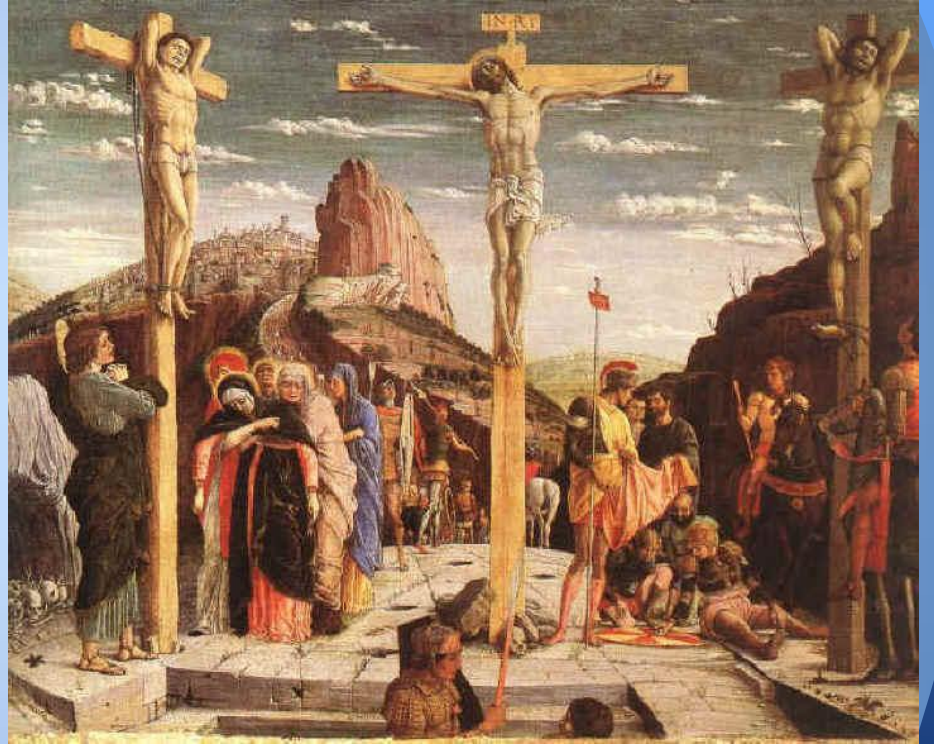
Jesus Christ died for man on the cross, but he will not die for us again.

Those who died and went to Hell from A.D. will not be sanctified as those from the old testament.

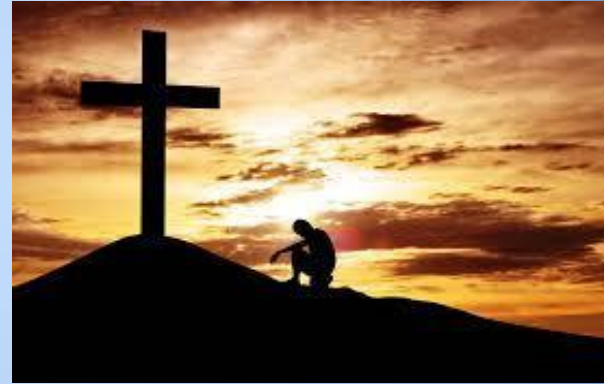
